

RoHS2, RoHS3, REACH (233 SVHC), ELV Directive Compliance

Introduction

STARTEAM shares in the world community's concern regarding environmental protection. STARTEAM strives to stay abreast of environmental regulations that relate to our customer products and their use in customer applications.

All STARTEAM's products are fully compliant, and we will continue to assure compliance as new products are introduced.

Scope

This policy and associated procedures apply to all directors, staff and contractors working for the company.

Policy

All products provided by STARTEAM are complying with the European Union Directive, 2011/65/EU on the Restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS2) and its amendment Directive (EU) 2015/863 (RoHS3).

The RoHS compliant products of STARTEAM do not contain Lead (Pb), Mercury (Hg), Cadmium (Cd), Hexavalent Chromium (Cr+6), Poly Brominated Biphenyls (PBB), Poly Brominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE) including Deca-BDE, and additional ROHS2 chemicals such as Bis (2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP), Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP) and Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) and Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) above the allowable limits.

STARTEAM supports the aim of REACH to improve the protection of human health and the environment through better and earlier identification of the intrinsic properties of chemical substances. STARTEAM meets all REACH requirements and provides its customers with information about substances in the products according to existing and future REACH requirements.

The status of the candidate list of the European Chemicals Agency is permanently monitored, including the possible need under Article 33 of REACH to inform product recipients and consumers if an article contains more than >0.1% by weight per article of any substance that is added to the SVHC candidate list in the future. STARTEAM's products do not contain any substances on the Authorization List and substances restricted under REACH (REACH Annex XIV and REACH Annex XVII), or all new substances to be included on the beforementioned list in the future.

Furthermore, the products of STARTEAM are conform with the End-of-Life Vehicles Directive 2000/53/EC issued by the European Union on October 21st, 2000.

Responsibility and Review

This RoHS / Reach / ELV policy is the responsibility of the Management of STARTEAM, the last update was in April 2023 and will be reviewed annually.
